

## Guillot Bourne

With over 350 varieties of deciduous and coniferous trees and shrubs, the Guillot Bourne nursery wants to focus on diversity and quality rather than quantity. As they have very specific climate and soil conditions, every year they plant some new varieties, so they can test them and see how they acclimate themselves in those conditions.

Doing this year after year, they have now gained a very wide knowledge about the best varieties to choose regarding the plantation's conditions for your landscaping projects. They have been strongly cooperating on different projects like a French botanical garden of a public castle where the goal was to focus on matching the right botanical varieties with the climate and pedology conditions.

Last year they transplanted many different kind of topiaries essentially for botanical gardens, although diversity of trees is also essential in avenues for a variety of different reasons: esthetic, less propagation of diseases and better solutions for the landscaping of cities.

At Guillot Bourne, oak trees are produced as standard trees in 30 different varieties, they produce other varieties in standard and multi-stem forms.
